CONSULTATIONS

New York State maternal mental health providers can schedule a consultation with expert psychiatrists in maternal mental health through an open conference line. The open conference line is available twice weekly on **Tuesdays from 5 to 6 PM** and **Thursdays from 1 to 2 PM**. Providers can schedule in advance a ten-minute window to call in to present cases or ask questions and get responses.

Providers may also submit non-urgent questions by email. Expert psychiatrists in maternal mental health will respond to all questions within two business days.

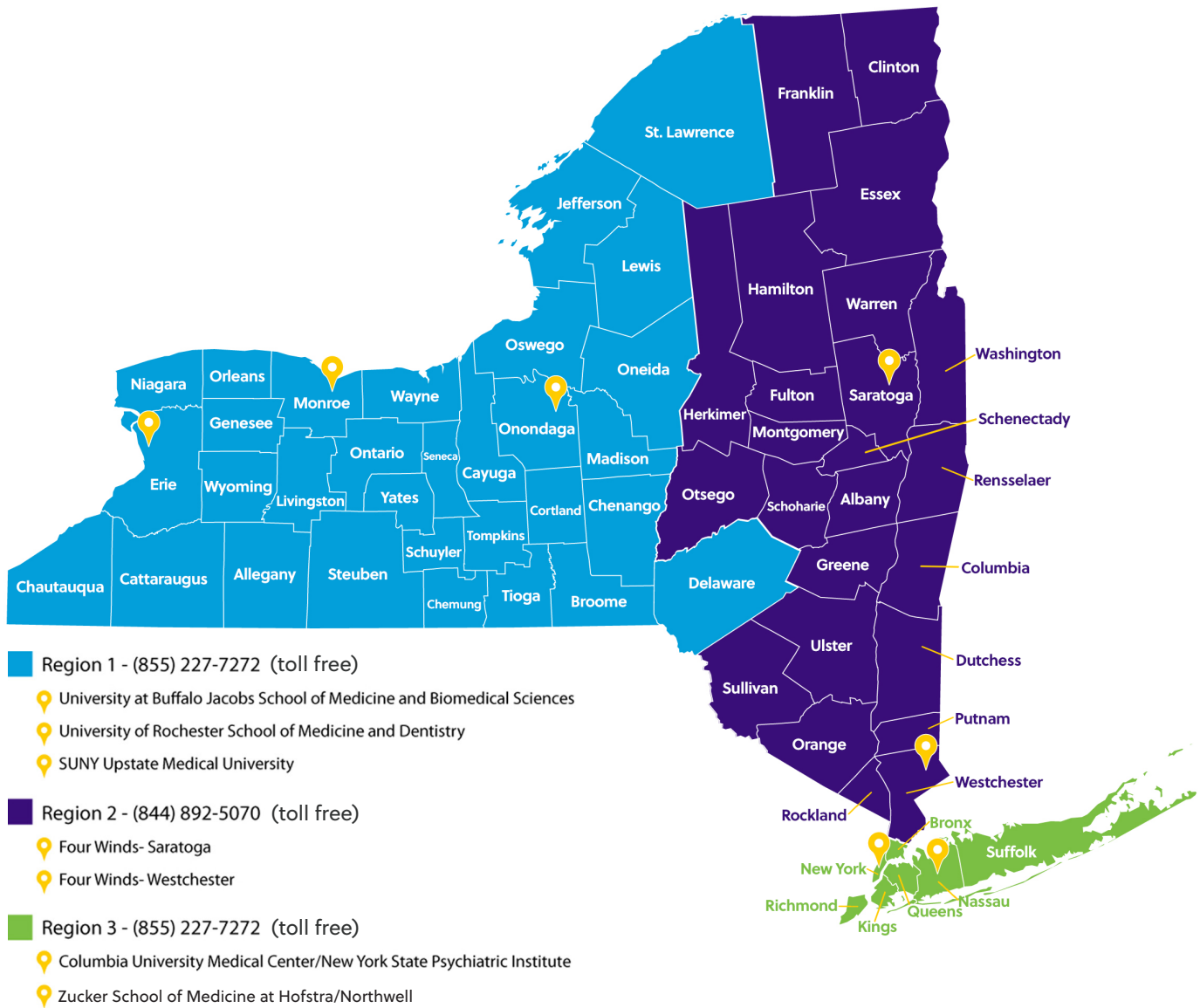


LINKAGES & REFERRALS
