MVP Health Care Offers Integrated Benefits D-SNP Plan in New York

MVP Health Care® (MVP) is proud to announce that beginning July 1, 2023, dual eligible individuals can enroll in the new MVP DualAccess Complete (HMO D-SNP) plan.

The MVP DualAccess Complete plan includes integrated benefits for dually eligible enrollees (IB-Dual). IB-Dual is a Dual Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) that offers Medicare Advantage and Managed Medicaid benefits with the same carrier. Members who receive Medicare Advantage and Medicaid benefits through the same carrier have access to increased intensive care coordination and efficient plan management.

This is MVP's second D-SNP plan. On January 1, 2022, MVP launched the MVP DualAccess (HMO D-SNP) benefit plan to serve individuals who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid in the Capital District (Albany, Columbia, Greene, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Schenectady counties), and the Hudson Valley (Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster, and Westchester counties). In January 2023, MVP added Monroe County to its service area. Members in the DualAccess plan would only receive their Medicare Advantage benefits through MVP. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has awarded MVP's D-SNP plan with 5 stars, which is the only 5-star ranking in New York State for 2023 plan year.

The new IB-Dual plan will be offered in the same counties as the original D-SNP plan with benefits effective August 1, 2023.

In addition to an intense level of care coordination, the MVP DualAccess Complete plan offers exclusive benefits, including:

Providing this level of coordination ultimately leads to better care, better outcomes, and lower costs for a population that often includes high utilizers of the health care system.
