Opioid Treatment Bundled Services Billing Update (Action Required)

MVP Health Care® (MVP) is committed to keeping you informed of changes that may impact your patients.

New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports' (OASAS) recently announced updates related to Opioid Treatment Programs (OTP) bundle service billing that may impact you. OTP bundled service billing and reimbursement are being brought under the Ambulatory Patient Groups (APG) Methodology.

The following changes went into effect July 1, 2024:

- To receive the bundled payment under APGs, OTP Programs should bill CPT Codes G2067, G2068, G2078 or G2079 when providing the bundle qualifying services
- Substance Use Disorder (SUD) services that fall outside of the OTP bundle can be billed on the same claim
- Claiming will continue to be weekly
- This change will also allow Providers who offer services in the community, including mobile medication units, to bill the bundles under the APG rate code 1088

OTP bundle transition period through November 3, 2024:

- Providers have the option of billing the bundled rate codes (7969-7976) or the bundles under the APG methodology through November 3, 2024

The following changes are effective November 4, 2024:

- Bundle Rate Codes (7969-7976) will zero out
- All billing for OPT bundle services under only the APG methodology

ACTION REQUIRED

Providers currently billing with the OTP Weekly bundle rate codes 7969-7976 will need to update their billing systems related to OTP bundle service billing prior to November 4, 2024.
